

## Wellingborough Kempo Karate Club Code of Conduct

## Students

- 1. Punctuality to be observed
- 2. Gi's to be kept Clean and Ironed
- 3. Fingers and toe nails to be kept short and clean
- 4. No swearing in the Dojo
- 5. Bow on entering and leaving the Dojo
- 6. Anyone with injuries must report them to the instructor before the training session begins. Injuries sustained during a training session must be reported to the senior instructor immediately.
- 7. All students must wear protective equipment when free fighting i.e. groin guard, gum shield, foot and hand pads.
- 8. All jewellery i.e. rings, earrings etc, must be removed before training begins
- 9. Bullying in any form in or out of the dojo will result in an **Unconditional Ban**
- 10. Misuse of Karate in or out of the dojo will result in an immediate Ban.
- 11. Disrespectful behaviour to either instructor or fellow student will result in downgrading.
- 12. Once graded, students must hold a current licence to participate in training sessions.
- 13. Instructors reserve the right to refuse membership.
- 14. Abide by all the club's Safeguarding and Code of Conducts Policies.

## Instructors

- 1. Instructors must always conduct themselves in a respectful manner to students, parents, visitors or instructors.
- 2. At least 1 Instructor to be present during each session that holds a valid First Aid and Instructors Insurance Certificate.
- 3. Training areas to be safe and appropriate spacing for students to avoid collisions
- 4. All instruction should be tailored to students age, abilities and grade.
- 5. All instructors should be aware of the clubs safeguarding and reporting polices,
- 6. Senior instructors have read and are aware of the club's adoption of the NSPCC policy on preventing abuse in position of trust and recent amendments regarding under 18's.
- 7. Abide by all the club's Safeguarding and Code of Conducts Policies.

## **Parents**

- 1. Are requested to deliver students on time.
- 2. Remain seated and not interrupt the lessons.
- 3. Must not use telephones or play loud games or music in the Dojo.
- 4. No taking photographs without prior permission.
- 5. Abide by all the club's Safeguarding and Code of Conducts Policies.
- 6. If in doubt, ask the instructors.
